Our days are full of such occurrences. Most of the time, I do not think about them. We tend to only notice the little things when they do not happen as we expect them to. Most of our potential problems are successfully avoided. Most of the time, we are surrounded by instances of blessing, for which we are right to feel gratitude and give thanks, but we don't even notice them.

We can help each other notice these blessings by sharing our stories of when we have recognized God's benevolence and goodness. Simply by passing on those moments when a "little thing" can be seen as important, we witness to how our lives are full of blessing. Sharing our stories can literally change how others see the world around them.

We've been sharing stories through the Epiphany season. I've been loving the stories shared, often of big and amazing ways that God's presence has been made known. These stories deserve to be shared! But we also need to grow in our ability to share these "small" stories. Any experience that can be used to give thanks to God is a story worth sharing.

In a world suffering from cynicism and despair, this witness of blessing is needed. We need to notice and lift up the presence of God that is always around us, and we need to help others see that God is also with them. Let us keep giving witness to a world where God's presence can be seen everywhere!
